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St John's Health has streamlined their operations using Multiview ERP

St. John's Health is in Wyoming in a prime access point to Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Park. The area attracts about 4,000,000 visitors during the summer and has three popular ski resorts active in the winter. The organization specializes in orthopedic cases, aligning with the area's recreational activities. With 120 beds including 48 for Acute/Primary Care, 16 for memory care, 15-bed Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF), St and 40 for skilled nursing. John's Health oversees six clinics outside the hospital and multiple on-campus clinics. The organization has experienced significant growth over the past 17 years, employing over 850 staff and undertaking substantial expansion projects in areas including the Operating Room, Obstetrics, Oncology, and Radiology. John's Health admits roughly 1,900 patients, delivers over 400 babies, performs 2,750 surgeries, and handles more than 8,500 emergencies.

Phillip Fox, the Director of Supply Chain at St. John's Health, leads a 12-member team responsible for daily operations. The team includes a departmental manager, two primary buyers for the hospital and clinics, a dedicated Operating Room buyer, and four logistics staff. The supply chain management team includes a receiving clerk, a courier, and a materials management assistant.

Challenges


St. John's Health faced substantial challenges in their accounting processes with the impending end of their existing ERP, Paragon. Data accessibility limitations led to manual efforts for critical information extraction, including time-consuming tasks like vlookups and pivot creation in Excel.

Additionally, the lack of seamless information flow between the supply chain and accounting departments resulted in manual invoice research, approval, and pricing updates. Despite using EDI (Electronic Data Interchange) for purchase orders, manual data processing persisted, slowing down operations.

Challenges in tracking supply chain information affected financial data collection, specifically regarding patient discharges and surgical procedures. Manual order entry and inventory management processes added logistical inefficiencies.

These numerous issues underscored the need for an integrated ERP solution to streamline operations.



Selection and Implementation

Selecting a new ERP was no small feat, especially with St. John's Health's Electronic Medical Records (EHR), Paragon being phased out. The decision-makers, a team made up of nurses, clinical staff, IT, and accounting professionals, chose Cerner (now Oracle Health) for their EMR. With that decision made, their focus shifted to finding an ERP that could manage their supply chain and accounting needs.
